

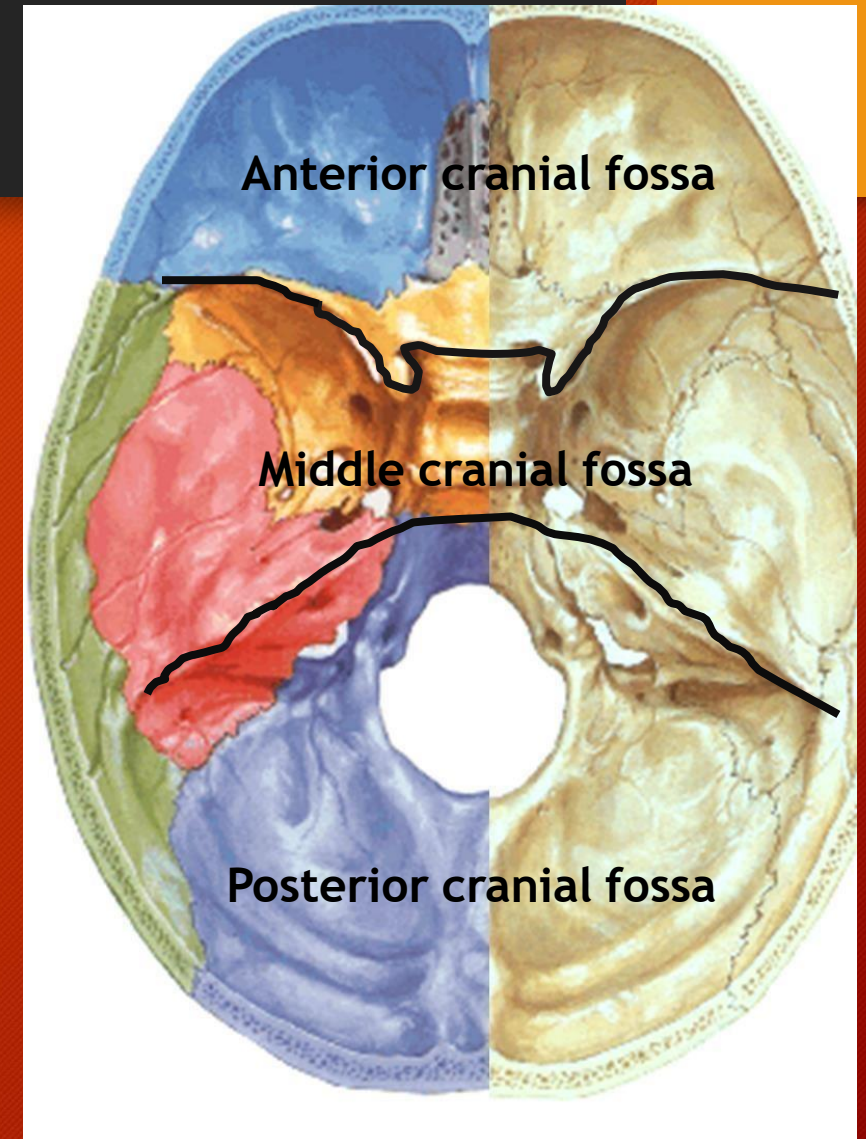

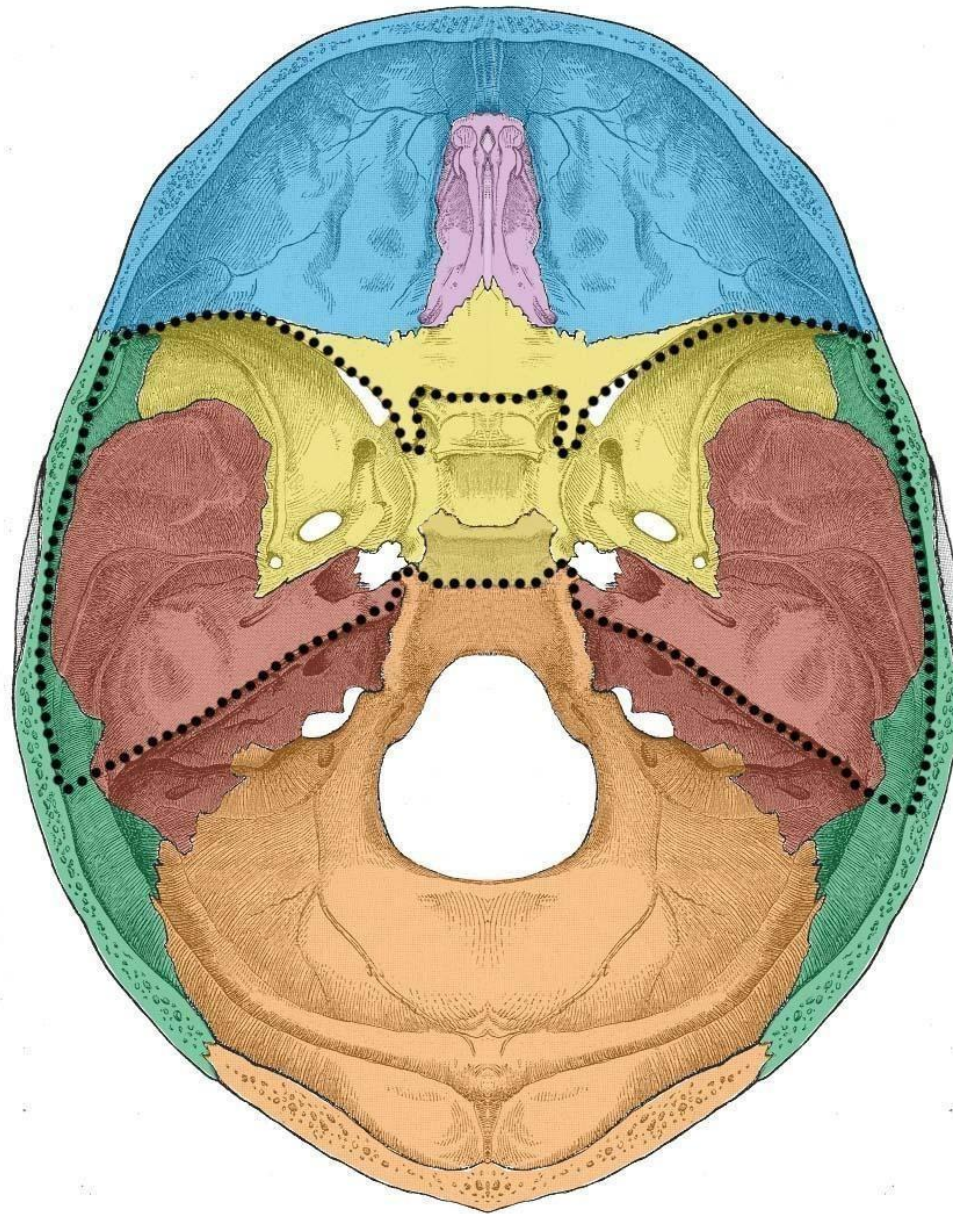

Norma basalis Interna

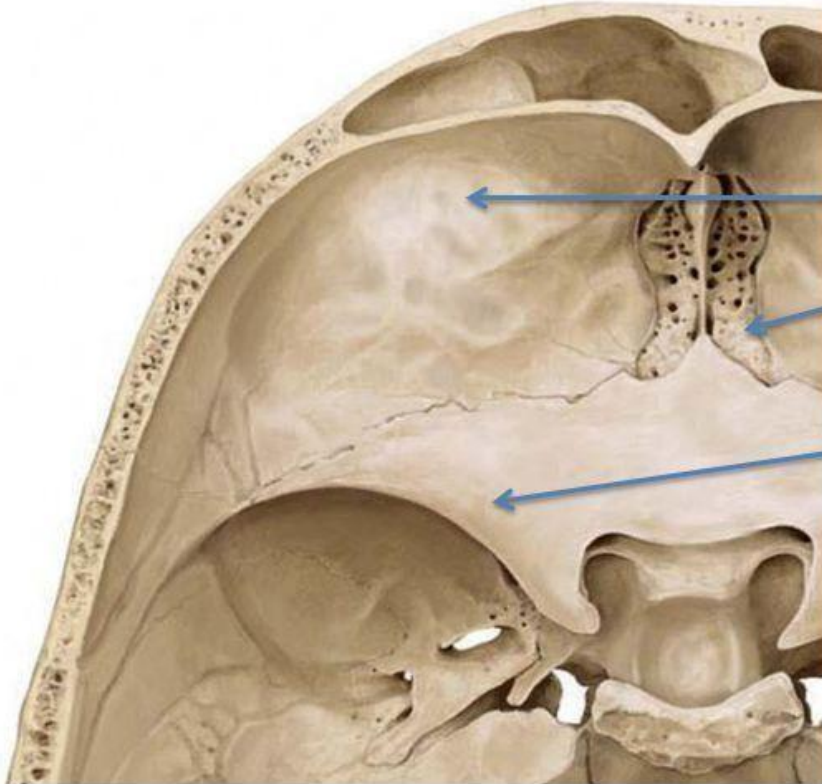
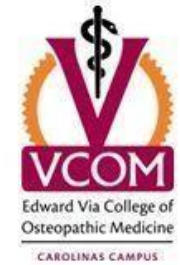
- The upper surface of the base of the skull, after removal of the skull cap.
- Divided into **3 cranial fossae**: Anterior, middle and posterior.





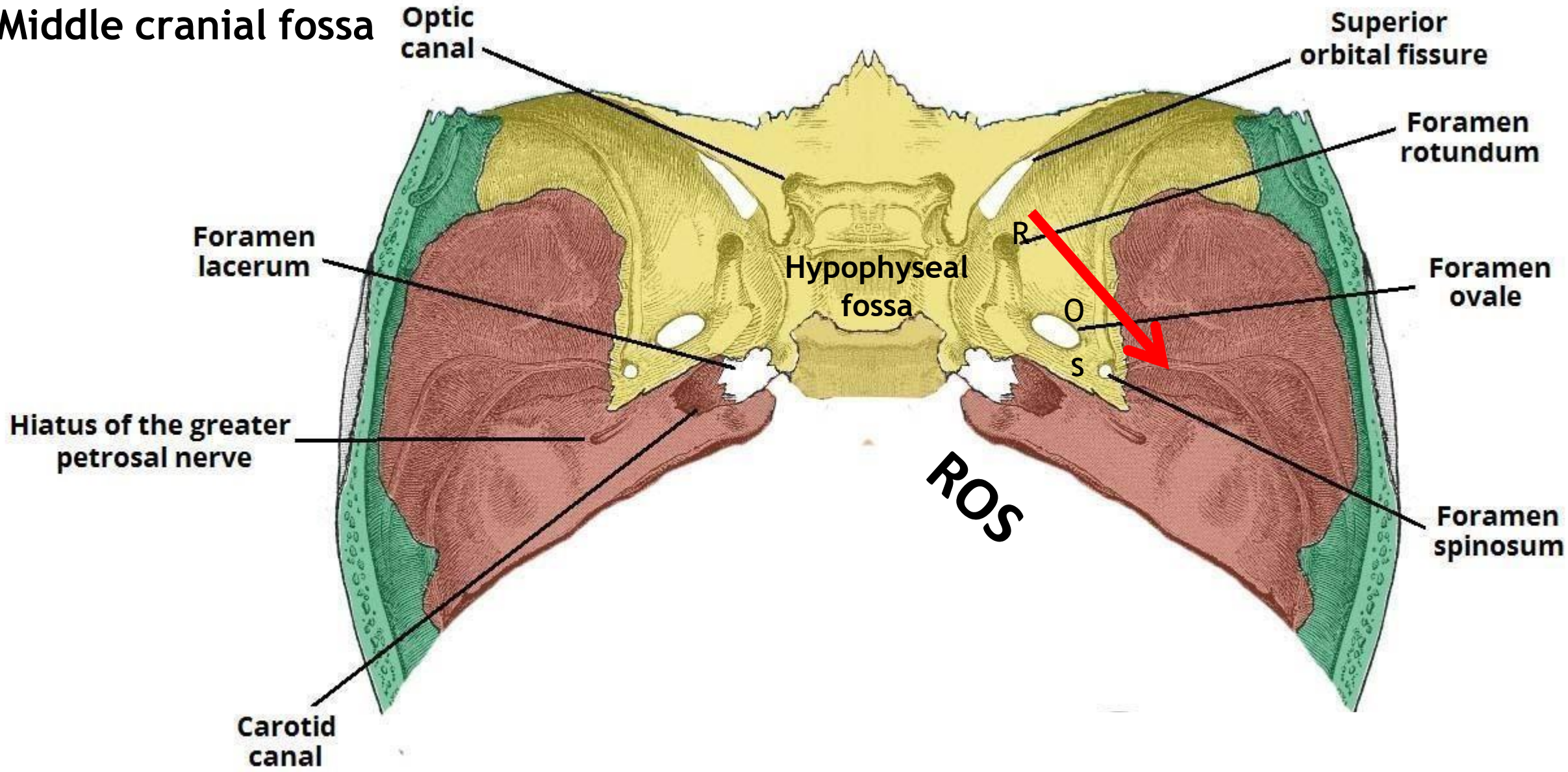

Anterior Cranial Fossa



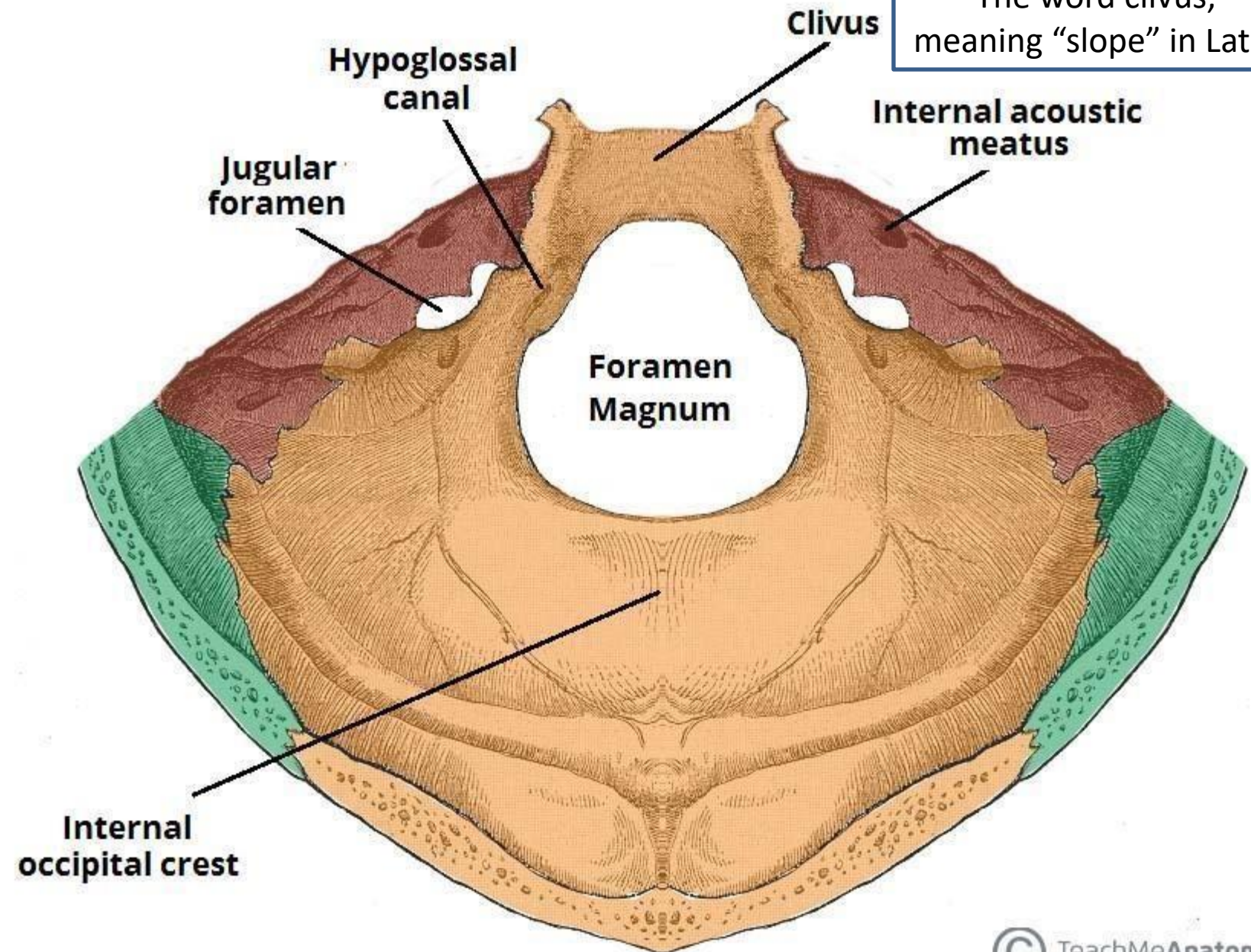
- Orbital plate of frontal bone
- Cribriform plate of ethmoid bone
- Lesser wing of sphenoid bone
- Body of sphenoid

Middle cranial fossa

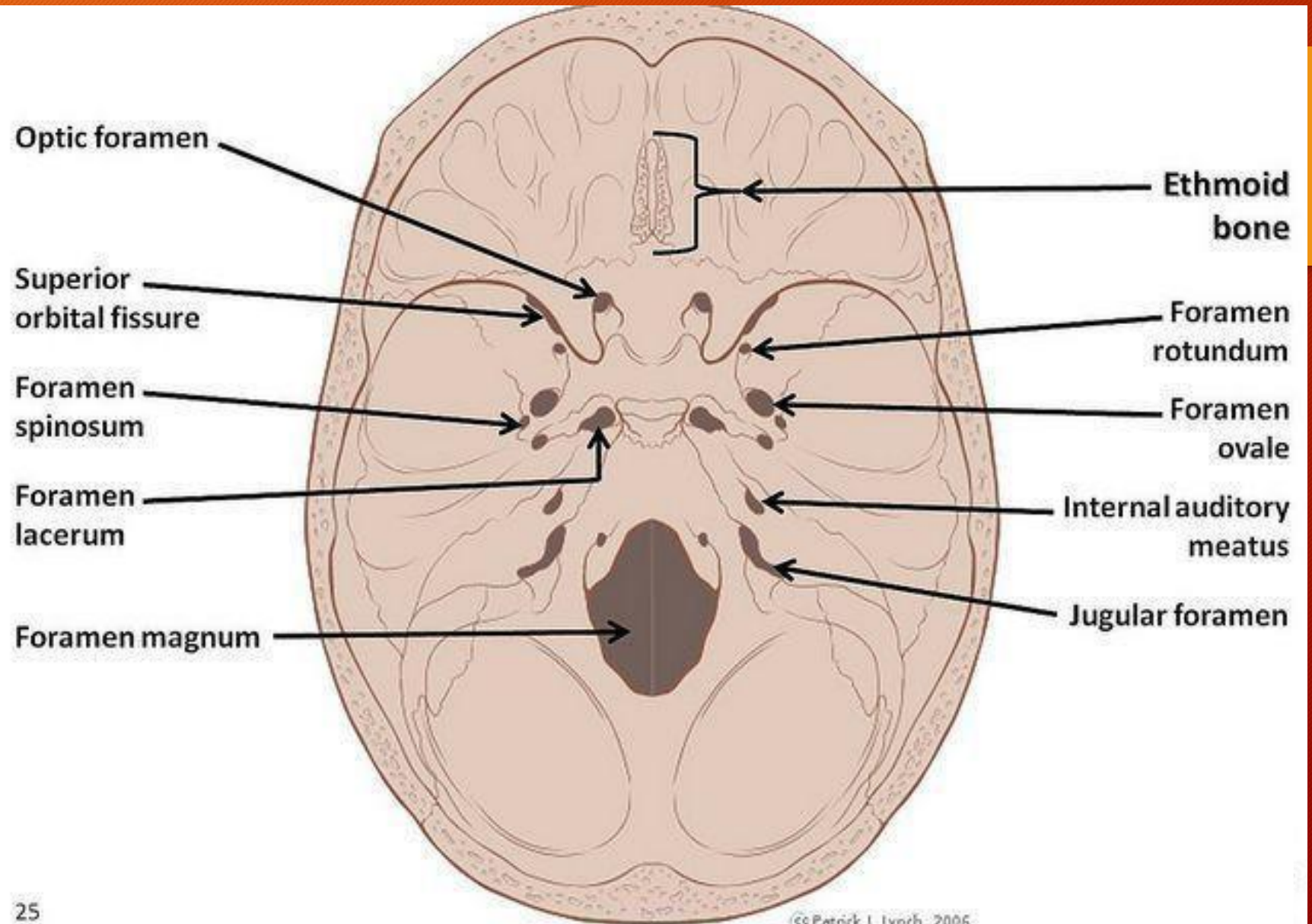


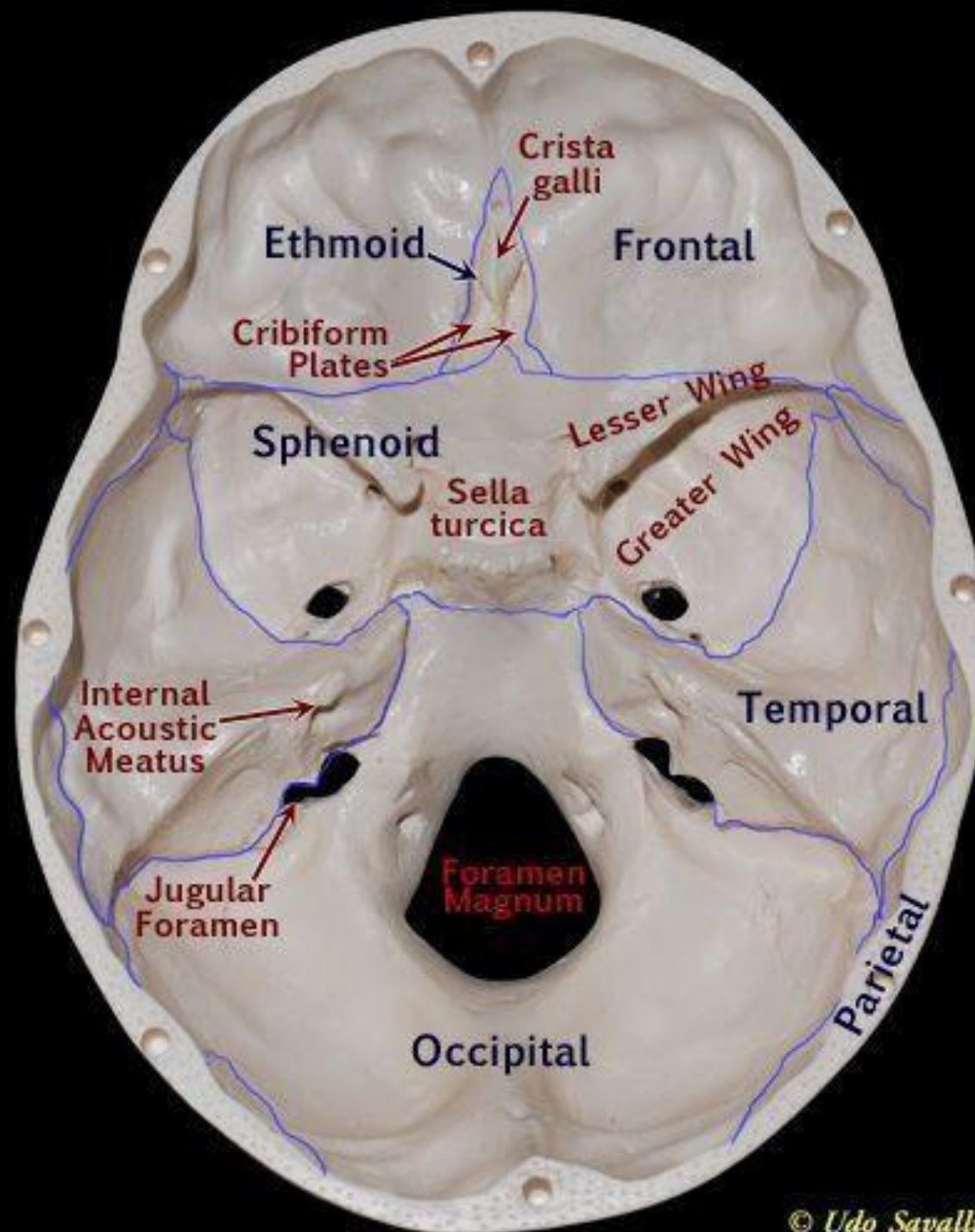
Posterior cranial fossa

The word clivus, meaning "slope" in Latin

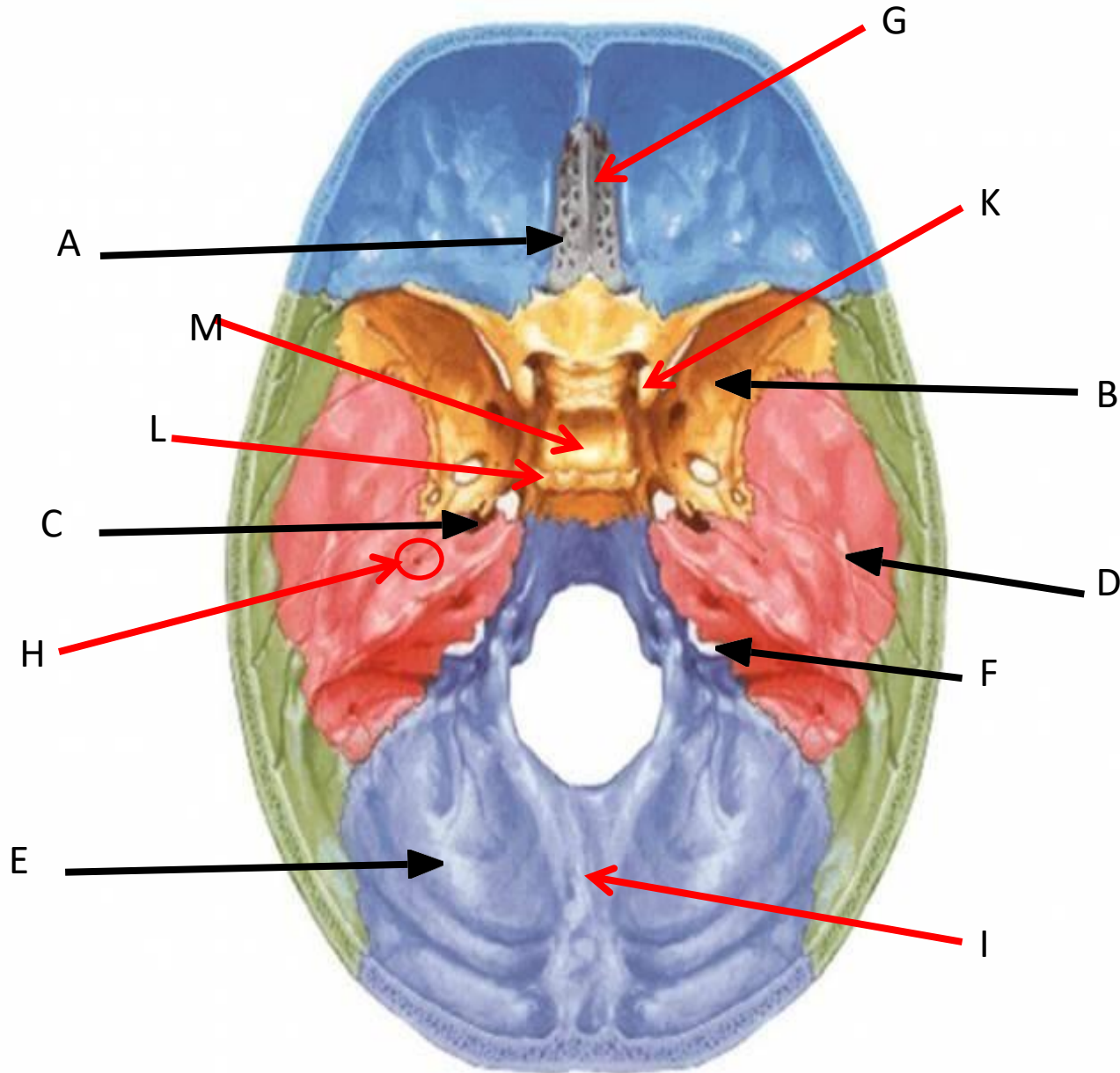


Foramina of the skull
